TRAFFIC ALERTS

Because the village office received many complaints regarding vehicles speeding on East and West Avenue in the village, a speed detection device was placed on West Avenue and clocked speeds as high as 57 mph. As both roadways are main carriers for vehicles going to and from Arkport School as well as the fact that these are densely populated areas, **PLEASE** obey the 30 mph speed limit which is currently in place.

This also brings up a concern with regards to our crossing guard at the school crossing. We've been alerted that on more than one occasion she's been close to getting hit by speeding vehicles and others not stopping for children to cross. This is a **20 mph** speed limit area during school days (Monday through Friday, 7:30 AM-3:30 PM) and the crossing guard is there for the safety of our children so again we ask that you PLEASE obey the traffic laws.

THE HISTORICAL SOCIETY IN ARKPORT, (CANISTEO VALLEY HISTORICAL SOCIETY)

There has been a historical society in Arkport since 1875! There have been pauses in Society activities over the years, but currently it has been active for over 15 years. At present, there are 324 members of the Society, from across 28 states. Our goal is the collection and preservation of historical knowledge in our area; we strive to promote the better understanding and appreciation of our American heritage. Our reach is beyond Arkport to the Upper Canisteo Valley, including neighboring hamlets and the City of Hornell.

Members are entitled to a quarterly newsletter, which is a popular item. We present two historical programs a year and the public is invited to attend. The Society also participates in Steuben County Historical Society activities and sponsors a scholarship to a graduating high school senior.
